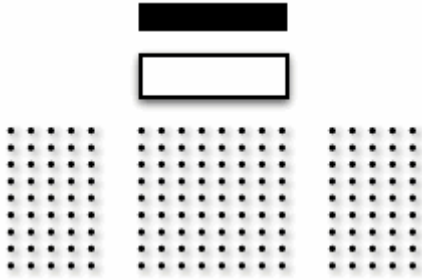

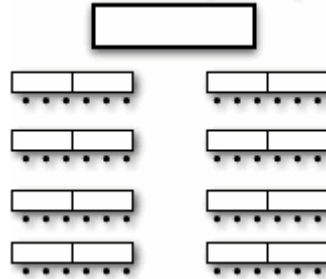

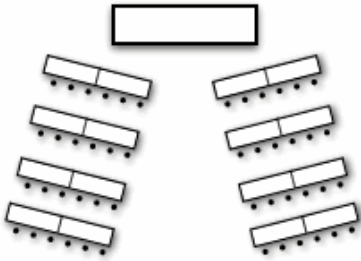
Theater-Style Setup



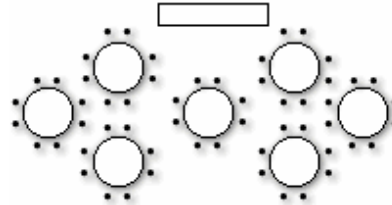
Classroom-Style Setup



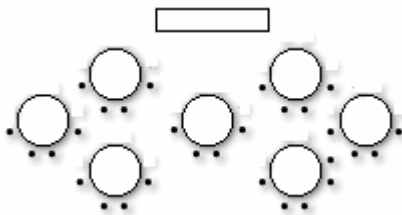
Chevron Classroom-Style Setup



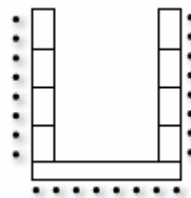
Rounds (Banquet)-Style Setup
